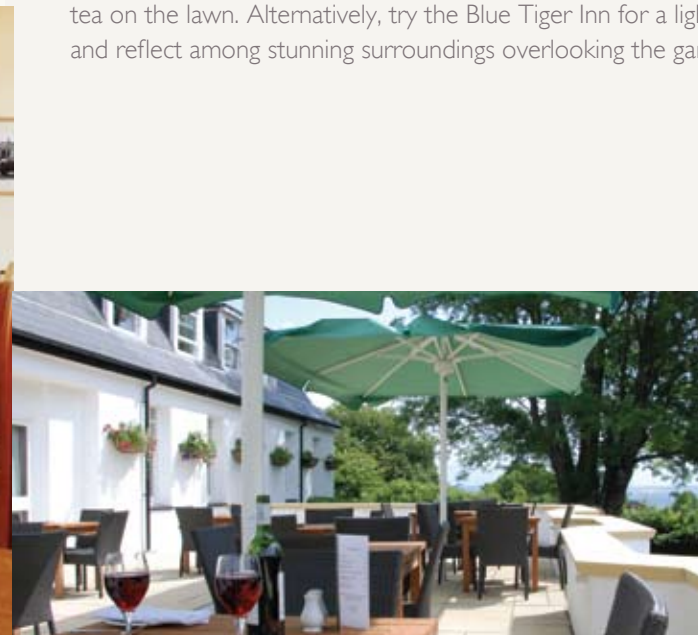


# Simply Dartmoor
