Terms & Conditions:

We recommend that guests take out insurance against cancellation of their reservation. In this case if the policy guarantees a reimbursement to the hotel of the total cost of the booking we will only request a deposit of £100 per room at the time of booking and the remainder will be due upon departure. Proof must be provided to the hotel that such a policy has been taken out at the time of confirmation (a cancellation insurance plan is available from the hotel on request however guests are free to use any policy of their choice).

Once confirmation of a booking has been received should the need to cancel the booking arise the full amount for the booking will be due unless the accommodation can be re-let in which case a full refund less an administration charge of £50 will be made.

If proof of a cancellation policy cannot be provided a deposit of 50% of the anticipated costs of the booking will be required on confirmation. The remainder of the amount due will then be paid to the hotel no later than 31st October 2009. Failure to do so may result in immediate cancellation of the booking and the original deposit may be forfeited.

The hotel reserves the right to change the advertised programme and menus at any time. No adjustment to the tariff will be made for any part of the package not taken.
